

Cue Sheet: Montgomery Magic Ride

Note: Mileage information for reference only.

Mile	Increment	Distance From End	Instruction	Compass
0.0	0.0	39.3	Start at Montgomery Town Hall, across street from bike shop in Montgomery Ctr.	NW
7.2	7.2	32.1	Turn right onto VT 105	NE
11.7	4.5	27.6	Turn right, staying on VT 105	SE
22.7	11.0	16.6	Top of VT 105 climb	--
26.1	3.4	13.2	Turn right onto Cross Rd.	S
27.7	1.6	11.6	Turn right onto VT 242	W
32.6	5.0	6.7	Top of VT 242 climb.	--
39.2	6.6	0.0	Turn right onto VT 118. Return to Town Office.	NW

Ride Rules

- Everyone must wear a helmet and straps should be adjusted correctly.
- Follow all traffic laws, including obeying signals.
- If the ride will wait for people at intersections, discuss this at the start.
- Use your own judgment at each stop sign. Don't yell out "Clear" for the next rider.
- Use hand signals for turns and to point out road hazards (If there are new people, review the rules.)
- Wear visible clothing. In fog and rain, you might also want lights.
- If there is a thunderstorm, get away from your bicycle and seek shelter in a building or a stand of trees (not a lone tree).
- Get license plate or description of harassing drivers, and report it to the police, the ride leader and the Vt Bike/Ped Coalition.
- Single up when cars are passing, out of courtesy.
- Wave your thanks to drivers who are polite and wait for you or even drivers who are a little rude.
- Finally, a quick safety check for your bike: ABC Quick Check
 - A=Air in tires
 - B= Brakes working
 - C=Chain lubed and crank in good shape
 - Quick=Quick releases tight
 - Check=Make sure everything else seems OK
