

Cue Sheet: GMBC Old Battles & Ferry Ride

Note: Mileage information for reference only.

| Mile | Increment | Dist to End | Instruction | Compass |
|------|-----------|-------------|---|---------|
| 0 | 0 | 36.3 | Park at Chimney Point Museum. Cross Crown Point Bridge. | SW |
| 2.46 | 2.46 | 33.8 | Turn left onto Lake Rd. | ESE |
| 3.74 | 1.28 | 32.6 | Turn left at T intersection after crossing RR tracks, staying on Lake Rd. | SE |
| 5.9 | 2.2 | 30.4 | Turn left at T intersection onto NY 9N & 22 | SW |
| 6.5 | 0.6 | 29.9 | Turn left at 4-way intersection, staying on NY 9N & 22 | ESE |
| 10.6 | 4.1 | 25.7 | Turn left onto Shore Airport Rd. | ESE |
| 14.8 | 4.2 | 21.5 | Turn left onto NY 74 & 22 | SE |
| 15.3 | 0.5 | 21.0 | Turn left, staying on NY 74, leaving NY 22 | E |
| 16.7 | 1.5 | 19.6 | Board oldest, continually operating ferry in US. Ride cable ferry to Vermont. | E |
| 21.5 | 4.8 | 14.8 | Turn hard left onto Watch Point Rd., just as you are coming into Shoreham. | W |
| 24.0 | 2.6 | 12.3 | Bear right , staying on main road, which becomes Lake Rd. | NW |
| 33.1 | 9.0 | 3.2 | Turn left onto VT 125 | NW |
| 36.1 | 3.0 | 0.2 | Bear left at intersection with VT 17, staying on VT 125 to parking lot. | WNW |
| 36.3 | 0.2 | 0.0 | End | SW |

Ride Rules

- Everyone must wear a helmet and straps should be adjusted correctly.
- Follow all traffic laws, including obeying signals.
- If the ride will wait for people at intersections, discuss this at the start.
- Use your own judgment at each stop sign. Don't yell out "Clear" for the next rider.
- Use hand signals for turns and to point out road hazards (If there are new people, review the rules.)
- Wear visible clothing. In fog and rain, you might also want lights.
- If there is a thunderstorm, get away from your bicycle and seek shelter in a building or a stand of trees (not a lone tree).
- Get license plate or description of harassing drivers, and report it to the police, the ride leader and the Vt Bike/Ped Coalition.
- Single up when cars are passing, out of courtesy.
- Wave your thanks to drivers who are polite and wait for you or even drivers who are a little rude.
- Finally, a quick safety check for your bike: ABC Quick Check
 - A=Air in tires
 - B= Brakes working
 - C=Chain lubed and crank in good shape
 - Quick=Quick releases tight
 - Check=Make sure everything else seems OK
